Free Cancer Screening Medical Camp.

A team of experts from RST Cancer Hospital, examined the people and conducted various diagnostic tests for screening of Oral Cancer, Breast and Cervical Cancer. Free Medical Camp was organised for sensitising people regarding various types of Cancer and for screening of Oral, Breast and Cervical Cancer. Total 124 people availed the free cancer diagnostic services at the camp.



Awareness Session on Basic Life Support (BLS) and Heimlich Maneuver.

Regional Institute-IV, Nagpur as part of Welfare Activities organised an Awareness Session on 'Basic Life Support (BLS)' and 'Heimlich Maneuver' in association with Lata Mangeshkar Hospital, Nagpur for the employees of RI-IV. Doctors/Nurses demonstrated BLS and Heimlich maneuver to employees. Basic Life Support is the first aid/ care given by first-responders, healthcare providers and public safety professionals to anyone who is experiencing cardiac arrest, respiratory distress or an obstructed airway. Whereas Heimlich maneuver is a first aid method used to relieve people from choking.






Special Campaign 2.0
