Exploration.

- During August 2023, CMPDI, along with various agencies under its supervision, has carried out 58742 metre of drilling against the target of 61610 metre, which is 95% of the target with a growth of 71% over the same period of previous year.
- Ministry of coal has taken various steps to achieve the physical as well as financial target of the NER component of CSS funding. During August'23, tender for exploration in 1 block in the state of Meghalaya having 0.01 lakh metre of drilling has been finalised by DMR, Meghalaya and LOA issued. Tender for exploration in 1 block in the state of Assam, having 0.12 lakh meter of drilling is under finalization.
- Geological Report of Mirzagaon Block (Non-CIL), Rajmahal Coalfield in the state of Bihar, covering an area of 46 sq km and having Measured Resources of about 2.8 BT has been submitted.

Project Reports:

During the month, a total of 8 Project Reports with incremental capacity addition of 51.38 Mty were submitted by CMPDI. This includes two (non-CIL) Project Reports for Talaipali OC of NTPC Ltd. with incremental capacity addition of 25 Mty and Manoharpur OC of OCPL with incremental capacity addition of 8 Mty and one high capacity underground Project Report for Borda UG (with Continuous Miner) of WCL with incremental capacity addition of 3.06 Mty

PM Gati Shakti- National Master Plan Portal:

CMPDI is engaged in development of GIS layers on the MoC Page of PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan Portal and Government Land Information System (GLIS). In the month of August 2023, boundary of acquired land along with cadastral details of various mines as received from CIL subsidiaries have been uploaded on the portal. A PM Gati Shakti Cell has been set up at CMPDI. Two projects namely Ramnagore Kalyaneswari, BCCL and Rangamati A, ECL were analysed on PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan and reports were submitted

Drone based Survey:

CMPDI has taken up the job of Drone based Photogrammetric Survey of abandoned mines of Central Coalfields Limited as per Directive of NITI Aayog. CCL has identified total 11 abandoned mines, out of which 2 are opencast and 9 are Underground. Drone Survey in 9 mines has been completed.

- EIA/EMP Reports: CMPDI has submitted 2 nos. of EIA/EMP Reports during the month

- Vriksharopan Abhiyan:

CMPDI planted 478 saplings across 20 locations of which 93 saplings were planted within office cum residential complex and balance 385 saplings were planted in villages, schools and other institutions. Additional 305 saplings have also been distributed among the local communities.

CMPDI organised one Day workshop on "Environmental issues in CIL" at CMPDI(HQ), Ranchi on 11.08.2023 to provide a platform for exchange of ideas and adoption of best practices to address different problems related to Environment issues which was attended by General Managers, Environment of CIL and its subsidiary companies.



Corporate Social Responsibility

CMPDI inks MoA with Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra.

CMPDI signed an MoA with Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra (NBJK), Hazaribag for sponsoring 20 youths for Govt. recognized 2 years Diploma course in Ophthalmic Assistant at Lok Nayak Jaiprakash Paramedical Institute, Chouparan, Hazaribag amounting to Rs.32 lakhs for the FY 2023-25. This is the second batch of students who will be benefitted under CMPDI's CSR Initiatives. Earlier in August, 2022 CMPDI had signed an MoA with NBJK to sponsor 20 students to pursue Diploma course in Ophthalmic Assistant for the FY 2022-24. This will benefit unemployed youths of Jharkhand state. The project aims to provide education at free of cost and 75% hostel fees to the eligible candidates.

CMPDI signed an MoA with Tata Cancer Care Foundation, Mumbai on 25.08.2023 for “Extending financial support to socioeconomic underprivileged people at Ranchi Cancer Hospital and Research Centre(RCHRC), Ranchi for Cancer diagnostic tests and treatment during FY 2023-25. This project costs Rs.1.82 crores. Under this project, CMPDI will bear the cost for the Cancer diagnostic tests of about 1615 people and Rs.1 Lakh/- towards cancer treatment of Twelve people who are not covered under any Govt. Health schemes.




National Sports Day.
