CMPDI RECEIVED EXPLORATION LICENSE FOR RARE EARTH ELEMENTS (REE) BLOCK IN RAJASTHAN



On 16.09.2025, CMPDI received the official Certificate of Exploration License for the Nawatala-Devigarh Rare Earth Elements (REE) Exploration Block in Rajasthan. Shri G. Kishan Reddy, Union Minister of Coal and Mines, presented the certificate to CMPDI at the National Seminar on the Centre of Excellence under the National Critical Mineral Mission held in Hyderabad. 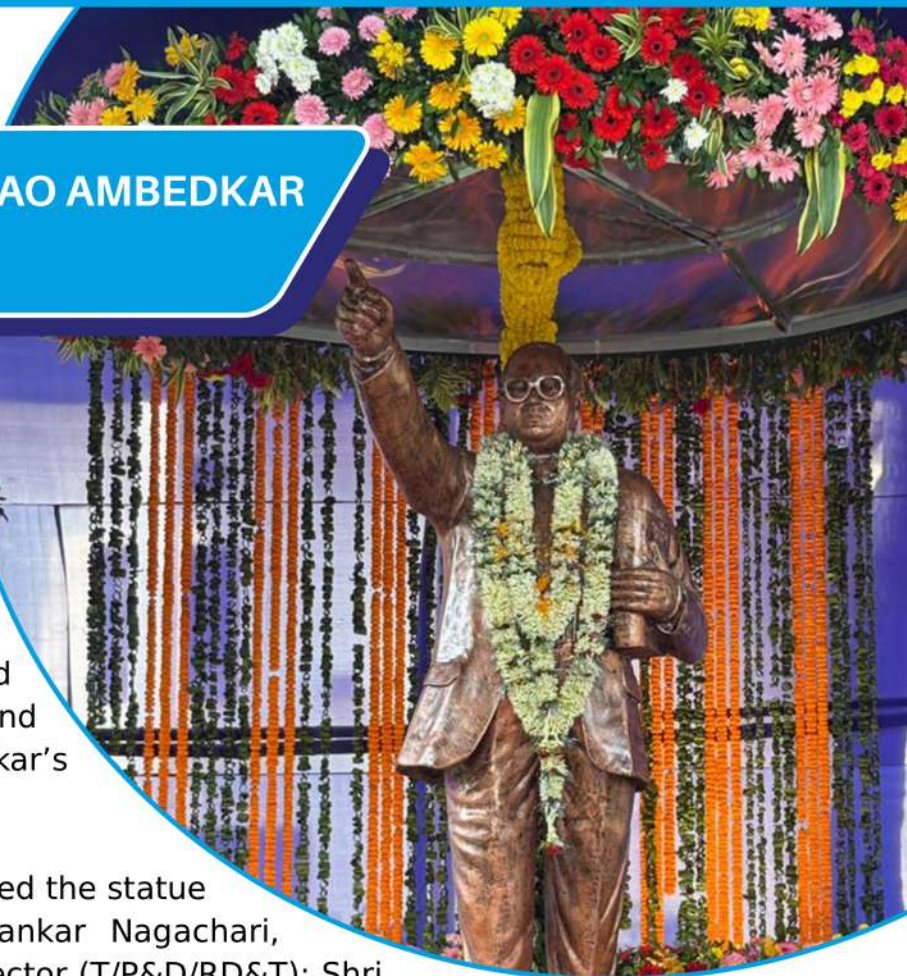
