6. ANY OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION, IF ANY

Regional Institute-2, Dhanbad:

1. Capacity Building and Training

A total of 26 employees were trained in Investigation & Report, and 17 employees were trained in Framing of Chargesheet. Additional capacity building included training 17 employees on GeM Make in India Procurement and 24 employees on Asset Management.

iGOT Courses: Employees actively utilized the iGOT platform, completing several modules focused on ethics and digital governance.

2. To ensure accountability and transparency in asset handling, detailed reviews were conducted:

Fixed Assets: Documentation for properties owned by the organization has been properly documented and verified. Furthermore, a letter was sent to BCCL for the execution of a property under lease, confirming active management of long-term assets.

Movable Assets: The inventory of movable assets (plant, machinery, office equipment) was reconciled. Crucially, the process of identifying obsolete items and initiating their survey off (disposal) was started, ensuring efficient use and accurate accounting of resources.

3. Community Outreach and Awareness Programs

The campaign prioritized public engagement to spread the message of vigilance and integrity beyond the organization:

Vigilance Awareness Program: A dedicated awareness program was successfully organized for the residents of Dhangri Basti on November 14, 2025, engaging the general public directly.
